


Education for all students

Framework for Junior Cycle

- inclusive education is one of the underpinning 8 principles
- appreciating and respecting diversity is outlined as a core area of learning
- the vision for junior cycle places students at the centre of the educational experience



Changing discourse around learning

- ability is not fixed
- all students have the potential to learn
- limitations are not set on possible future developments
- opportunities to engage with learning are ongoing
- Iearning does not take place in the same way or at the same rate for every child








Junior Cycle Choice & Flexibility
